**WORK SESSION**

**CALL TO ORDER, INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

Mayor Houston called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Councilmember Sibley gave the invocation.

**2018-207 CONSIDER AND DISCUSS AUDIO/VISUAL UPGRADES AND A POTENTIAL REMODEL OF THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS AT CITY HALL AND DIRECT STAFF AS NECESSARY.**

Chris Dick led the Council through a discussion of proposed audio and video upgrades and a potential remodel to the dais in City Council Chambers. Following discussion, it was the direction of the City Council to obtain more information on the audio piece of the proposal and bring back to Council for review.

**2018-208 Consider and discuss a remodel of the Police Department facility and direct staff as necessary.**

Carl Smith provided a brief presentation of the proposed remodel to the Justice Center. Council requested a cost estimate be prepared and brought back to Council during its July 24 meeting.

**2018-209 CONSIDER AND DISCUSS A REQUEST FOR THE PURCHASE OF ADDITIONAL WATER RECEIVED FROM MT. PEAK SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT AND DIRECT STAFF AS NECESSARY.**

City Council discussed a request from Mt. Peak SUD to purchase an additional 1MGD of water. It was the consensus of Council to reconsider the request at a later date.

**2018-210 CONSIDER AND DISCUSS THE PROPOSED MIDLOTHIAN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT (MISD) FIELD USE AGREEMENT AND DIRECT STAFF AS NECESSARY.**


City Council reviewed a draft Interlocal Agreement with MISD regarding joint use of the athletic fields at Frank Seale Middle School and Walnut Grove Middle School. Council requested the finalized agreement be brought back for consideration after the MISD Board of Trustees approve said agreement.

**2018-211 CONSIDER AND DISCUSS POSSIBLE SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS TO THE NORTH 8<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND WEST AVENUE F INTERSECTION AND DIRECT STAFF AS NECESSARY.**

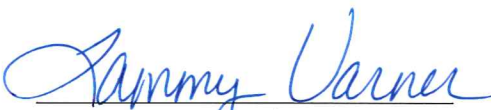
Council and staff discussed safety concerns and traffic issues a four-way stop would cause at the above-referenced intersection. Council consensus was to continue to monitor the traffic flow.
